### Admission Requirements

The following are required by Centennial Flight Centre to process your application for admission.

1. Proficiency in reading and writing of the English language.
2. Ability to obtain a Canadian aviation medical at the standard for the licence being sought.
3. Proof of sufficient funds including anticipated living expenses.
4. Must be 18 years of age.
5. Must be able to meet the eligibility requirements for Visa to enter Canada as a student.

### How to apply:

To apply for entry into the Professional Pilot Program you must complete an application for admission and submit it to Centennial with a \$2000.00 CDN application fee and proof of admission requirements as listed above.

### Start your training:

We accept admission into the Professional Pilot Program throughout the year, however we recommend starting the program in March to take advantage of the summer weather to complete the basic training portion of the program.

### Payment of fees:

Payment for training is made from moneys held on account with Centennial. Students must maintain a minimum level of \$1500.00 CDN in their account. Payment must be made before training can begin. Payment may be made by cash, major credit cards or a bank cheque made payable to Centennial Flight Centre Inc. Personal cheques must clear the bank prior to being accepted as payment. Cheques take up to 10 business days to clear, therefore to avoid delays in training, payment should be either certified, cashier, or official bank cheque.

### Refund Policy:

If a student withdraws from the program within three days of an initial introduction and tour of our facilities, all moneys paid on account will be refunded.

If a student contract is terminated after the vocational training begins, the Centennial is entitled to the following amounts of tuition:

- (a) when 10% or less of the vocational training has been provided, 25% of the tuition;
- (b) when more than 10% but 50% or less of the vocational training has been provided, 60% of the tuition;
- (c) when more than 50% of the vocational training has been provided, 100% of the tuition.

Expenses for training, books and training supplies, no show fees, and examination fees will be itemized. Credit for books or supplies returned in unused and unmarked condition and with direct proof of purchase may be granted.

### Accommodations:

Centennial will assist students to find appropriate accommodation upon arrival in Edmonton.
